Medication

Children who have been administered Calpol or paracetamol at home should not attend the nursery, as it could mask the start of an illness. The child can return to the nursery after 12 hours from taking the medication if they have no further symptoms.



Warmer weather

As the weather gets sunnier the children will need to bring in sun hats and have sun lotion applied at home before they attend their session. Please put suntan lotion into your child's bag so that the nursery can reapply suntan lotion in the afternoon to children who attend both the morning and afternoon session that day. Children are still required to have two pairs of footwear, one pair for inside and one pair for the garden area. The footwear should not have laces, as children are encouraged to become independent in changing their own footwear. Due to the weather getting warmer we will be outside playing with water. Please can we make sure all children have a change of spare clothes.

If your child is toilet training, please make sure you pack plenty of changes of clothes.

Please make sure all belongings are clearly labelled so that any lost items can be returned



Absences

Please can we remind parents to contact the nursery to report if your child is going to be absent before their session is due to start. If we have not herd from parent/career 15 minutes after the start of session we will make contact with you to find out why your child/ren are absent.

Fees

All outstanding fees must be completely paid in full by Thursday 29th June.

Water Bottles

Please can all parents provide their child with a clearly labeled water bottle. Please can we ask all parents to stop their children from banging/ rattling the gate in the morning. This is to prevent the gate from breaking. If your child needs to go to the toilet before the nursery opening time, please ring the doorbell.

Sessions

Please can we remind you to arrive on time for your sessions. As this can be very disruptive for the other children and upsetting for your own when arriving late.

This also applies at pick up time. Please can we make sure we are arriving on time to collect your child/ren as this can be very upsetting for your child when they are left waiting alone.

Late Collection fee of Child will be an additional charge of £7 per 15 minutes for children who are collected more than 15 minutes late from the child's agreed session or without prior permission.

Places for siblings

The nursery has received an influx of enquiries for new children to attend. Whilst this is wonderful news, the nursery would also like to be able to offer spaces for siblings of existing children. If your child has a younger sibling that will be requiring a space at Bear Hugs Nursery, please speak to Fiona asap, so they can reserve their place.

Extra Hours for September 2023

If you would like your child to increase their hours in September, please contact the nursery and speak to Claire or Sophie.

Chair Removal

After half term the blue chairs where children leave their belongings throughout the day will no longer be available. These have been replaced with a clothes rail so your child/ren can hang up their coat and their bags placed underneath. This is so we can free up more space in the hall to be able to provide the children with more play space and have room for other activities which can be provided all the time like sand and water.
