If your child was born between **1 September 2018 - 31 August 2019** they will be due to start school at an infant or primary school in **September 2023**. You will need to register your child for a school place, the deadline for registering is **15th January 2023**. Online applications are now open at www.surreycc.gov.uk/admissions or you can complete a paper copy. The local schools will have open days and we recommend you contact the schools directly or visit their websites for details.

Nappies

Please can you make sure your child has enough nappies and wipes in their bag. If your child does a morning or afternoon session only, please make sure there is at least two nappies, if your child does all day then please make sure there is at least 4 nappies. Please can I also remind parents not to provide pull ups.

Clothing and footwear

As the weather is now colder, please can you insure your child has hat, gloves, and a coat for garden time.

All children must have two pairs of footwear. Preferably veloce plimsols for the inside and wellington boots for the garden area. No lace up footwear.

Also, please ensure your child has a full set of extra clothing including socks for situations where they require changing through drink spillages, wet play, etc.

If your child is toilet training, please make sure you pack plenty of changes of clothes.

If you are considering toilet training, please speak to your child's key worker who will be happy to discuss with you our toilet training guidelines.

Toys

Please can we remind parents not to send their child into nursery with any toys, as this can become very upsetting for your child when they become lost, broken or even when another child tries to play with the toy. Bear Hugs nursery does not take any responsibilty for any lost or broken toys.



Sessions

Please can we remind you to arrive on time for your sessions. As this can be very disruptive for the other children and upsetting for your own when arriving late.

If you require an extra session, then please speak to a member of staff who will be happy to help. Extra sessions costs for a morning or afternoon are £21 or £7 an hour. This can be paid in cash or via BACS using your child's name as the reference, Account Name: Bear Hugs Nursery, Account No: 84174269 Sort Code: 60-23-40. Extra sessions are only available if we have the available space, we unfortunately do not offer you to swop or change your days for any missed sessions.

Lunch boxes

In line with the nursery's healthy eating policy, it is recommended that your child's lunch should provide a healthy balance of fruit, vegetables, yoghurt, and protein such as egg, ham, or cheese. Although, your child may have a maximum of one treat, such as a cake or biscuit, your child should not have sweets, chocolate, or sugary drinks in their lunch box. Forbidden and uneaten food will be put back into your child's lunch box.

Please can I also remind parents to cut up any choking hazards you may put into your child's lunch box, such as grapes, tomatoes, blueberries etc. These should be cut lengthwise into quarters. Never slice widthways because they'll still be big enough to choke on.

Bear Hugs Nursery in now a juice free nursery and will only be able to offer your child milk or water to drink during the day.

Medication

If you have administered Calpol/Nurofen to your child, they should not attend nursey for 24hrs from the time when the medicine was ingested. This is because Calpol and Nurofen can mask the effects of illness which could then be passed onto other children.

If your child has been prescribed antibiotics the exclusion period is 48hrs to ensure your child does not have an allergic reaction and to give the antibiotics time to work.
